

Minutes of November 13, 2025, Hingham Town Council Meeting

November 2025 Hingham Town Council meeting was called to order by Mayor Thomas Peterson on November 13, 2025, at 7:30 pm. Present: Thomas Peterson, Sandi Peterson, Dave George, Roger Haas, Jason Myers, and Dan Horinek also Patron Ray Lipp was present. The October minutes were reviewed. The treasurer's report was covered. Dave made a motion to approve both minutes and treasurer report, Dan seconded, and motion carried.

HEARING OF PATRONS: Ray had nothing.

OLD BUSINESS:

Lagoon Operator – tabled. Refuse Board- tabled. Rules and regulations – ongoing. Revisiting the town ordinances- ongoing. All curb stops need to be located and remapped. Digital speed limit sign-Mayor Peterson has talked to Commissioner Strissel, and he will need to get with the county on placement. Water loss will continue to be monitored.

NEW BUSINESS:

Council decided that we will get 6 yield signs from the county. Mayor Peterson talked about a culvert that has been driven over, and should we have the resident that has driven over it pay to have it replaced when the damage needs replacement. The council said let's wait and see. Mayor Peterson informed the council that we did receive a letter from MMIA that as of June 1, 2026, they will no longer handle Worker's Comp. Mayor Peterson asks the council to inform Sandi of purchases made on town accounts and what they are for so she can code them correctly. The council discussed bringing gravel in and having the roads graded before we have snow. Roger said that a resident has concerns as to why we have not had another meeting with RPA (our engineer for the wastewater project). Mayor Peterson informed the council that we have had numerous conference calls and meetings with RPA and that he has kept the council informed. He stated that if anyone has questions or concerns, they can contact him.

DELINQUENCIES/NOTICE TO DISCONNECT: NA

MAYOR'S REPORT: Mayor Peterson talked about the property at 15 2nd Ave and that he has not had the opportunity to shut the water off and that we have tried several times to contact the number on the window and no one has returned our calls so it was decided we will turn the water off. Mayor Peterson informed the council that the PACE sewer cleaning went well and wondered if we should extend it to every 4 years per half the town. Dave made a motion for every 4 years, Roger seconded it, and the motion carried.

Claims for #6383-6394 were read; Roger made a motion to accept the claims, Dave seconded the motion, motion carried. Next meeting is December 11th @ 7:30 pm. Dave made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Jason seconded the motion, and the Motion carried.
